Enervolution is a boutique advisory and research company focused on AI-augmented energy and carbon governance in developing and emerging economies, with a particular emphasis on Europe–Africa partnerships. We work at the intersection of power systems, sustainable biomass/carbon use and the water–energy–food nexus, helping regulators, DFIs, regional institutions and hard-to-abate industrial sectors design and implement robust transition pathways grounded in data, systems thinking and real-world constraints.

Who we are

Enervolution is a specialised consulting and research firm led by Dr George Kyriakarakos, an energy systems engineer with two decades of experience across EU institutions, international financial institutions and African Union organs. The company operates as a high-calibre external brain for organisations that need to design, govern and stress-test complex energy and carbon transitions rather than simply commission another report.

The Enervolution identity reflects this systems perspective: a planetary arc and interconnected nodes symbolising energy, land/biomass and water/systems, linked through a central integration point. This is how we work—connecting sectors, scales and stakeholders through a coherent analytical core.

What we do

1. AI-enabled power and energy governance

Integration of AI and advanced analytics into planning, operation and regulation of power systems in low-capacity and emerging-market contexts.

- Governance frameworks for transparency, accountability and human oversight of AI tools used by regulators, system operators and utilities.
- Design of AI-ready regulatory and institutional arrangements for grid codes, market rules and data governance.

2. Sustainable carbon for drop-in fuels, PtX and industrial defossilisation

Strategic assessment of sustainable biomass and biogenic carbon resources for e-fuels, SAF, methanol and other renewable drop-in fuels.



- Design of governance and allocation frameworks for cross-border sustainable carbon value chains between Europe and partner regions, balancing external demand with domestic priorities for energy access, food systems, land use and rural development.
- Support to DFIs, EU institutions, GIZ and regional bodies such as the African Union on policies, standards and investment screening that ensure externally sourced carbon feedstocks are environmentally robust, socially legitimate and compatible with partner countries' long-term strategies.
- Advisory services for industrial companies in chemicals, pharmaceuticals, textiles, plastics and related sectors on technically and economically coherent defossilisation pathways, including biomass-to-X routes (for example gasification plus Fischer–Tropsch) that can operate initially on sustainable biomass and residues and later integrate green hydrogen as it becomes cost-competitive, maximising carbon utilisation.

3. Rural electrification and the water–energy–food nexus

System design and policy support for mini-grids, productive uses of energy and climate-smart agriculture.

- Integration of digital tools, remote sensing and AI into planning and monitoring of decentralised systems.
- Concept development for advanced closed-loop systems (controlled-environment agriculture, space analogues) used as laboratories for robust resource-governance thinking.

Enervolution primarily supports:

- Regional and continental institutions – African Union organs, regional power pools and RECs on market integration, regulatory harmonisation and energy transition strategies, often in the context of partnerships with the European Union.
- Development partners and DFIs – EU services, GIZ, World Bank/ESMAP, AfDB and other IFIs seeking cutting-edge yet practical thinking on AI, digitalisation and sustainable carbon within their energy and external-action portfolios.
- Industrial companies in hard-to-abate sectors – chemicals, pharmaceuticals, textiles, plastics and advanced materials firms that must defossilise carbon feedstocks and process energy while operating within evolving EU and international climate regulations.

Working model

- For larger or multi-country assignments, Enervolution curates small teams of experienced associates and partner organisations rather than building a large internal staffing pyramid.
- Most outputs are deliberately placed in the public domain, often accompanied by open tools or supplementary material, reflecting our commitment to global public goods and knowledge sharing.
